TERM 1 DATES

Your child is automatically enrolled in 2020 unless I hear from you. You do not need to re-enter details with Enrolmy but you can update addresses and phone numbers yourself if need-be. (Please also flick me an email if you change your contact details.) You can check term dates on your Enrolmy too. As some classes have waiting lists, you will be charged for any classes you do not show for if I haven't heard from you. If your child would like to pick up an additional Arts a Go Go! class, or swap to a different class, please let me know. Please see some classes that I am featuring later in this newsletter. Your child is welcome to try a class first. Drama and Irish Dancing groups and times were emailed at the end of last year. Please email me if you need this sent again. TERM 1 FEES

For consistency of fees throughout the year, unless stated, Arts a Go Go! runs for 9 weeks (or rehearsal equivalents) per term, regardless of the length of the school term.

Fees are due by the third class of each term and internet payments are preferred. (Please contact Rachel if you need to arrange a cash payment). Although the option comes up on Enrolmy, we do not accept credit card payments at this stage due to the extra charges that would incur.

Invoices will be sent through Enrolmy soon or you can pay now as per the amount and account number below.




